**On March 30<sup>th</sup>, at 6 P.M.** you will have the opportunity to participate in a *Healing and Wholeness Service* here at the KUMC sanctuary. This is a joint ministry of KUMC and Bethel Presbyterian. Leading the service will be Rev. Marc Sherrod and Parish Nurse Deborah Hyder. The purpose of this service is to present the total ministry of Jesus Christ's teaching, preaching with an intentional focus on healing. Wholeness suggests the healing of the mind, body and the spirit. There might be attitudes and emotions between persons, families, cultures, races or even nations that need healing. Wholeness can occur wherever brokenness is encountered in life.

In a Healing and Wholeness Service the mood is one of sincere worship and prayerful seeking. At a healing service each worshiper is made aware of God's love and forgiveness, acceptance and pardon, wholeness, and salvation, peace and joy, encouragement and hope. When people experience Christ's presence in their lives, healing and wholeness happen. During the service each one will have the chance to be individually anointed and prayed for. We plan to continue these Healing and Wholeness Services every 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday throughout the year.
