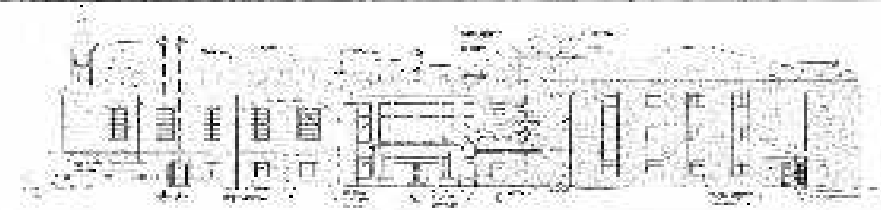

While there are a variety of organizational patterns, grouping people by age is still the most logical and effective structure. Our Children's Ministry is age-graded and designed so that children in each group interact with

peers and learn with others at similar developmental stages – just like in the school setting. The Sunday School Curriculum we use (beginning with preschoolers (ages 3 & 4) is geared toward these specific developmental stages. Our Kids Church curriculum is designed for school-aged children Kindergarten through 5th grade. We ask that children attend the appropriate age level classes provided– both for Sunday School and Nursery/Kids Church during the worship service.
