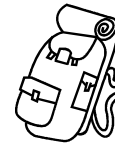

Hall. Children of all ages are invited to participate – join us for practice on Sunday morning's in the annex from 8:30-9:25. Breakfast provided.



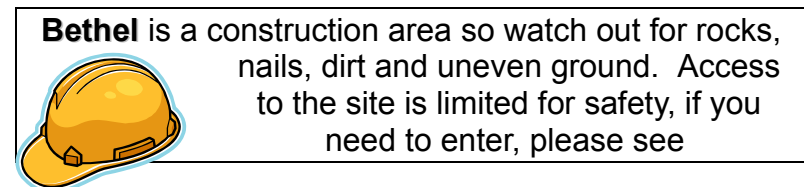
