as I delight in serving your world this day. Amen.

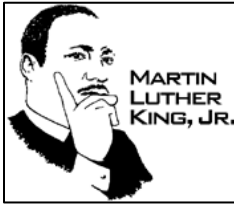
REFLECTIONS
