FEBRUARY 22 @ 6:30 PM ASH WEDNESDAY SERVICE

The season of Lent, beginning with Ash Wednesday on February 22, is a time of prayer, humility, focus, and self-examination in preparation for the celebration of the resurrection of the Lord at Easter.

Lent is a period of 40 days — like the flood of Genesis, Moses' sojourn at Mount Sinai, Elijah's journey to Mount Horeb, Jonah's call to Nineveh to repent, and Jesus' time of testing in the wilderness. The Sundays in Lent are not counted in this reckoning of the time between Ash Wednesday and Easter, as every Lord's Day is a celebration of the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

You are invited to attend Bethel's Ash Wednesday Service on Wednesday, February 22, at 6:30 p.m. to receive a cross of ashes on your forehead. These ashes, made from the burned palms of the previous year's Palm Sunday, serve as a reminder of mortality, death to dust, and the need to ask God's forgiveness.
