Attention: This week the church office will only be open Monday – Thursday from 9:00 AM – Noon.

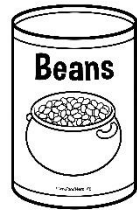


It's not too late to support One Great Hour of Sharing. You can use the envelope in the pew or write OGHS on the memo line of your check.
