August 14th has been designated by Bethel's Fellowship Team as "Undie Sunday" – a back-to-school project to benefit children attending our local schools. Many low-income parents worry about their child having enough



socks and underwear and these items are not usually found in thrift stores. Bethel's contributions will help to provide basic clothing items that school officials suggest are most requested: **Girls' and Boys' Undies, Socks, & Sweatpants or Leggings-Size 5/6 and Size 7/8,** but larger sizes, including adult size underwear is also needed.
