Please be seated. As the music plays, a candle lighter will come to the end of your pew. The candle of the first worshiper in each row will be lit, then they will light the candle of the person next to them, in that way the light of Christ is passed from person to person.

# (To avoid spilling hot wax, please keep your candle upright allowing the person next to you to light their candle.)

After all the candles are lit, we will stand to sing "Silent Night"
