This special service proclaims the Word not through a sermon but through nine 'lessons,' or scripture readings, and nine accompanying carols. Today's service honors the structure of this traditional service while incorporating different scripture readings and carols to tell the Christmas story.

Lighting of the Candles

- (Light #4) We remember God is Love.
