### INSTALLATION OF RULING ELDERS – CLASS OF 2025

Sentences of Scripture (L = Leader, P = People)

- L: There are varieties of gifts, but it is the same Spirit who gives them.
- P: There are different ways of serving God, but it is the same Lord who is served.
- L: God works through each person in a unique way, but it is to God's purpose that it is accomplished.
- P: To each is given a gift of the Spirit to be used for the common good.
- L: Together we are the body of Christ, and individually members of it.

#### Statement on Ordination

We are called into the church of Jesus Christ by baptism, and marked as Christ's own by the Holy Spirit.

This is our common calling,

to be disciples of Jesus Christ and servants of our servant Lord.

Within the community of the church,

some are called to particular service as deacons, as ruling elders, and as ministers of Word and Sacrament.

Today we install four from our congregation to active service as ruling elders.

## (The Clerk of Session)

Representing the one holy catholic and apostolic church, the session of Bethel Presbyterian Church now installs Brenda Bunch, Jim Condon, Larry Koppelberger, and Elaine Steele to active service as ruling elders in this congregation.

All have been previously ordained.

## Constitutional Questions to New Elders

Brenda, Jim, Larry, and Elaine, in baptism you were claimed by the love of God, clothed in the grace of Jesus Christ, and anointed with the gifts of the Holy Spirit to share Christ's mission in the world. Now you are called by God through the voice of the church for new service and ministry in Jesus' name.

- In accordance with the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (USA), please show your commitment to this calling by responding to these questions:
- Do you trust in the Lord Jesus Christ your Savior, acknowledge him Lord of all and Head of the Church, and through him believe in one God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, do you? **I do.**
- Do you accept the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments to be, by the Holy Spirit, the unique and authoritative witness to Jesus Christ in the Church universal, and God's Word to you, do you? **I do.**
- Do you sincerely receive and adopt the essential tenants of the Reformed faith as expressed in the confessions of our church as authentic and reliable expositions of what Scripture leads us to believe and do, and will you be instructed and led by those confessions as you lead the people of God, do you and will you? **I do, and I will.**
- Will you fulfill your ministry in obedience to Jesus Christ, under the authority of Scripture, and be continually guided by our Confessions, will you? **I will.**
- Will you be governed by our church's polity, and will you abide by its discipline? Will you be a friend among your colleagues in ministry, working with them, subject to the ordering of God's Word and Spirit, will you? **I will.**
- Will you in your own life seek to follow the Lord Jesus Christ, love your neighbors, and work for the reconciliation of the world, will you? **I will.**
- Do you promise to further the peace, unity, and purity of the church, do you? **I do.**
- Will you pray for and seek to serve the people with energy, intelligence, imagination, and love, will you? **I will.**
- Will you be a faithful ruling elder, watching over the people, providing for their worship, nurture, and service? Will you share in government and

discipline, serving in councils of the church, and in your ministry will you try to show the love and justice of Jesus Christ, will you? **I will with God's help.** 

Constitutional Questions to the Congregation (Clerk of Session)

Do we, the members of the church, accept Brenda, Jim, Larry, and Elaine as ruling elders, chosen by God through the voice of this congregation to guide us in the way of Jesus Christ? **We do.** 

Do we agree to pray for them, to encourage them, to respect their decisions, and to follow as they guide us, serving Jesus Christ, who alone is the Head of the Church? **We do.**
