Dear Friends,

March brings Spring, hopefully a break from the rain of February and most importantly the season of Lent. As always, we will have our pre-Lent observance at the Shrove Tuesday pancake supper, Mar 5 at 6pm. We will share pancakes with each other, play some pancake games, and enjoy some final indulgences before Lent begins the next day. Our Ash Wednesday worship service will be held in the Fellowship Hall on Mar 6 beginning at 6pm. We will share a potluck soup meal (no desserts!) followed by worship. This is a particularly child friendly Ash Wednesday service that includes the imposition of ashes, so be sure to bring your children or grandchildren, or neighbor kids! We will continue our study of Isaiah during Lent on Wednesdays after Ash Wednesday with a prepared meal at 5:45 and the study at 6:15pm.

During the Season of Lent we examine our lives to see where are living into the Kingdom of God here and now and where we are missing the mark on that. It is a time to pray, meditate, seek forgiveness and imagine how to live into this new life we are given more faithfully. In worship during this season we will reflect on the verbs fasting and feasting, waiting, delivering, changing, and perceiving as we seek to understand more fully what faithfully living into the Kingdom of God here and now is all about. This exploration that begins with Ash Wednesday worship will continue through Holy Week. Maundy Thursday and Good Friday Services (April 17 and 18) will provide additional means of exploring these actions. Look for more information about Holy Week services in the April Open Door.

If you have not walked the labyrinth and would like to or you want to learn more about that, I invite you to join me Thursday, March 7 at 10am. I will offer some guidelines for walking the labyrinth as a spiritual practice. I will also be available at 10am on Thursdays throughout Lent for those who want to engage in this practice of mediation, prayer and reflection. Blessings to each of you during this journey of Lent.
